During the last financial year of 2024 – 2025, OBS was very much focused to its aims and objectives. OBS has tirelessly toiled on the domains of education, health, livelihood and advocacy actively. Other activities were also being carried out concurrently such as animation, and capacity building of youth, women and farmers. From the point of economical intervention was done through strengthening of 32 farmers' clubs and livelihood support accompanied

with trainings and exposures under the project titles; Sustainable Transformation through Agriculture Nurturing & Development (STtAND) and Leveraging Agriculture Nurturing & Development (LAND) have immensely contributed in improving the quality of life of farmers.

OBS is committed to the cause of promoting inclusive society in state of Tripura and supported 350 children with disability and 50 children without disability through CBM. OBS has extensively and comprehensively supported socio-economic and health intervention to attain the goal of inclusive society by forming 34 Inclusive Parents Groups (IPG).

“SOS” is interpreted as “Save Our Soul” which is a universal distress signal used to request urgent help in emergencies. On August 18, 2024, Tripura experienced relentless rainfall which triggered severe flood, landslides and humanitarian crisis. The disaster claimed many lives, injuries, and displacement. Tireless efforts were made to respond the flood relief as the state was in SOS situation. **MISSION OFFICE TECHNY (TE)** promptly reached out to more than 1000 flood victim families through Oisho Bani Society during distress situation. Our sincere thanks to Mission Office Techny for the prompt action and generosity.

Before closing I would like to thank all the generous supporters and contributors in our activities. I acknowledge our partners, stakeholders, donors, well-wishers and the local community.

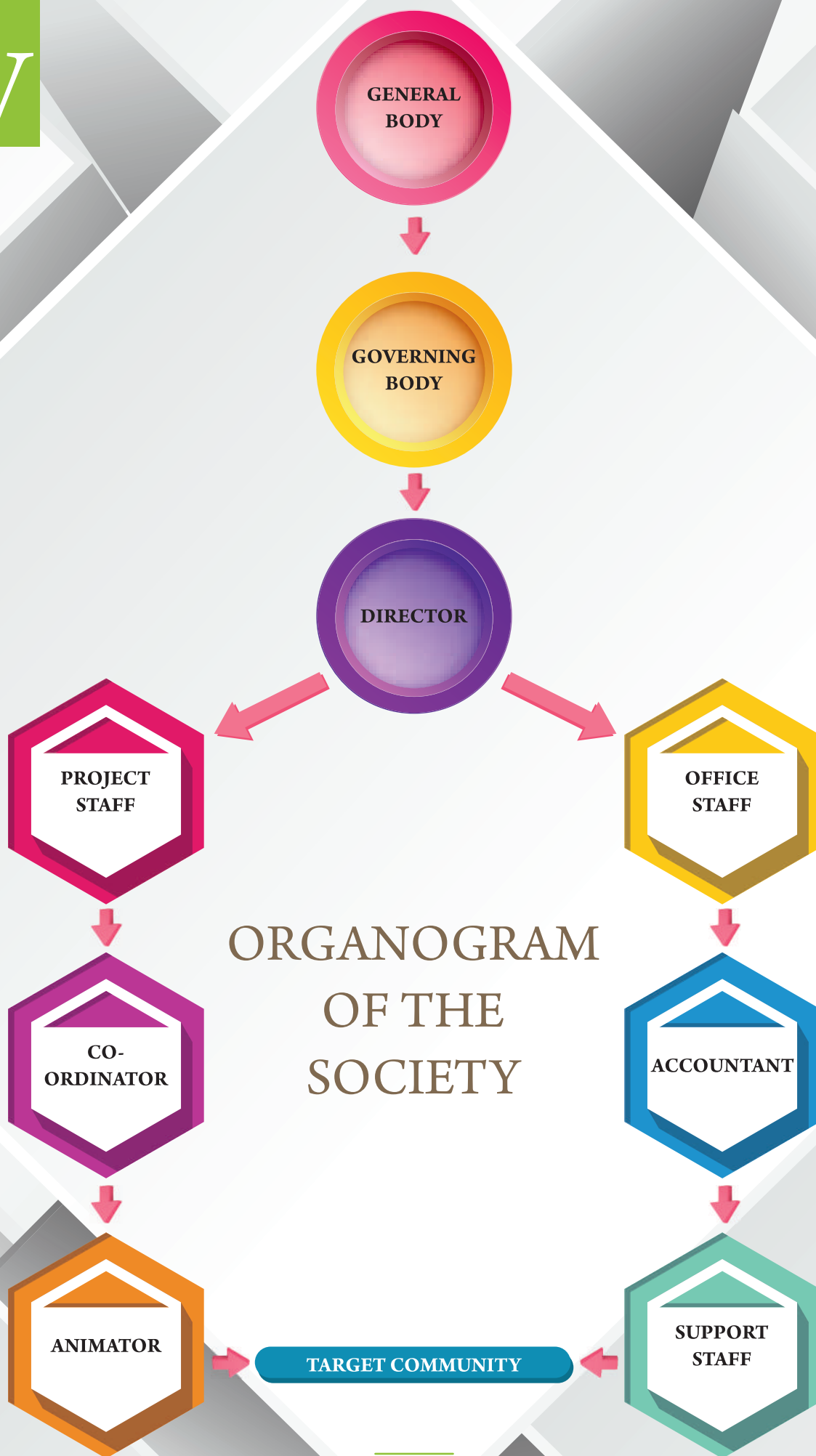

# PROGRAMME AND PROJECTS

## 1 EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

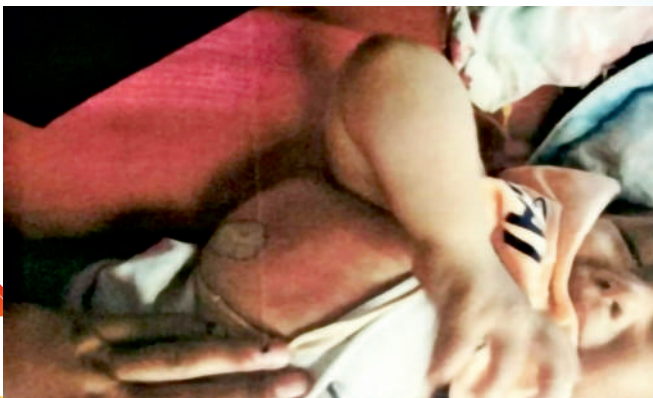
Oisho Bani Society has played a vital role in educating the tribal poor children in far flung rural North East India. Despite the challenges, above 6000 children are benefiting from Education ministry of which majority belongs to indigenous group. Through education ministry Oisho Bani Society has been transforming tribal societies by empowering youth, promoting gender equality and fostering socio-economic development. Oisho Bani Society's continued focus on quality and inclusive education is important role to bridge gaps and ensure holistic progress among the tribes of North East India.

### INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Oisho Bani Society reached out individual students for educational support in the ways of school fee concession, hostel fee concession, text books, uniforms etc. Students and guardians have experienced much relief in education of the children.



## 2 MEDICAL SUPPORT



### i) Mr. Biplob Ch. Paul (Rs. 25,000/-)

In the month of February Rajdeep met with fatal bike accident. In an accident he was seriously injured. His right leg and right hand were fractured. Because of the fall he also got internal injury in his chest. Pain was unbearable and entire things turned into worse. Rajdeep was admitted in ILS Hospital Agartala for the treatment. Parents became utter helpless due to the accident. Lots of money was spent for the treatment of the child. With helpless situation Mr. Biplob Ch. Paul was supported financially from Oisho Bani Society. A sum of Rs 25,000 was promptly transferred directly to Mr. Biplob's bank account to cover the partial medical expenses.

### ii) Medical Help for Nur Amin (Rs. 15,000/-)

Nur Amin, a welder from Lakhimpur, suffered serious injuries to his head, ear, neck, and backbone when a wall collapsed while he was repairing his house roof. A sum of Rs. 15,000/- was given as medical help from Oisho Bani Society.

### iii) Mahesh Dako's Wife's Treatment (Rs. 15,000/-)

Rs. 15,000/- was given to Mrs. Pokio Dako's treatment as she suffered from Hepatitis B sickness. The family also faced the financial burden but because of Oisho Bani Society's help the family got much relief.

### iv) Medical Treatment (Rs. 20,000/-)

A sum of Rs. 20,000/- was given as financial assistance for the medical treatment of Iska Mary Pamblang who was diagnosed with soft tissue vascular malformation.



### 3 PROGRAMME AND PROJECTS

i. Marchila Basumatary a resident of Udalguri District in Assam received sum of Rs. 20,000/- from Oisho Bani Society for the partial completion of her house. This assistance brought much relief and improved their living conditions.



ii) Tunu Debbarma, a resident of Kamranga in the Dhalai district of Tripura, received sum of Rs. 20,000/- from Oisho Bani Society for the partial completion of her house. This assistance brought much relief and improved their living conditions.



iii) Pushpa Rani Debbarma, a resident of Shrirampur village in Kamalpur, Dhalai district, Tripura, has been struggling with severe financial difficulties for a long time. Oisho Bani Society reached out the family of Pushpa Rani Debbarma for financial assistance for partial completion of the house.



iv) Mr. Sumit Halam (Rs. 15,000 + 15,000 = 30,000/-)

Mr. Sumit Halam, a resident of Bagmara, Ambassa, Tripura, comes from a humble background where he supports his wife and two children. Recognizing the severity of Mr. Sumit's family circumstances, Oisho Bani Society gave the financial assistance of thirty thousand (Rs. 15,000 + 15,000 = Rs. 30,000/-) for partial completion of the house.



iv) Mrs. Shephali Marak resides in Udaipur, Tripura, along with her children. Their living conditions were challenging. Oisho Bani Society helped the family to build the house partially for which Rs. 20,000/- was given.





## 4 RESEARCH INITIATIVE



Oisho Bani Society has its own research institute known as SANSKRITI, the North Eastern Institute of Culture and Research. Through the research centre, OBS has published number of research papers and articles in the leading journals and books. The institute has been hosting regional and national seminars and workshops on different subjects related to indigenous culture.

A conclave on “Culture, Tradition and onward journey of Tribals in Tripura” was conducted on 10th August, 2024 at Khwumlung, Tripura. The scholars and academicians from Tripura participated and shared their ideas. On 7th and 8th of December, 2024 two days Annual National Seminar on Cultural Heritage and Empowerment in India Contemporary World: Harnessing Diversity, Technology, Talent and Vision was conducted at SVD House, Guwahati.



# 5 SUSTAINABLE TRANSFORMATION through AGRICULTURE NURTURING & DEVELOPMENT (STtAND)

“Sustainable Transformation through Agriculture Nurturing & Development” (STtAND) is a successful project for the farmers implemented in Kamalpursub-division in Dhalai District of Tripura. Impact of the project is that the tribal families under Kamalpur Subdivision in Dhalai District in Tripura, increased food security throughout the year and adopted organic farming and animal husbandry as sustainable livelihood. The following activities have been completed during the reporting period.



## Activities

1. Training on pickle making
2. Training on organic farming, indigenous pest control and livestock rearing
3. Training on First Aids and vaccinations for livestock.
4. Agriculture Risks and Disaster Management.
5. Awareness on Health, Hazardous and Medical Camp for the farmers.
6. Training on Bookkeeping and Financial Literacy Program.
7. Awareness on Digital Farming for the Farmers.
8. Livelihood support to 16 farmers' clubs
9. Linkage with development agencies and Govt. Departments.





## 6 LEVERAGING AGRICULTURE NURTURING & DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (LAND)

The name of the project is “Leveraging Agriculture Nurturing & Development” (LAND) which is operation in and around Khmulwng, Jampuijalavillages under West Tripura and Sepahijala District. This project aims at improving the quality of life of farmers and ensuring food security by promoting organic farming and other allied activities like animal husbandry, horticulture fish farming etc.

### Activities

1. Awareness on Farmers' clubs and organic farming.
2. World Environment Day.
3. Farmers' Day (KisanMela).
4. Government Linkage Program.
5. Exposure Visit.
6. Training on Organic Manure.
7. Livelihood Support.





# 7 FAMILY QUALITY OF LIFE: A PROJECT TO SUPPORT CHILDREN WITH AND WITHOUT DISABILITIES AND THEIR FAMILIES IN THE STATE OF TRIPURA

The overall objective of the project is; To improve the quality of life of children including children with disabilities and their families through holistic development.

The specific objective of the project, “To improve the participation of 400 children with and without disabilities and their families in Health, Education, Livelihoods and Social Inclusion activities in two blocks namely Dukli, Old Agartala and Agartala Municipality Corporation of West Tripura District. Principal activities are such as, Screening and Medical camps for the Children with Disability (CwD) and without disability, Assistance for Entitlement of CwDs, Awareness on Inclusive Education and Capacity building and Livelihood based trainings.

1. Screening and Medical camps for the Children with Disability (CwD) and without disability
2. Assistance for Entitlement of CwDs
3. Awareness on Inclusive Education
4. Capacity building and Livelihood based trainings.





# 8 ANIMATION AND CAPACITY BUILDING

## 8.1 Leadership Training Program

Oisho Bani Society (OBS) organized a one day seminar for leaders of Ambassa sub-division. There were 74 participants from different villages both men and women. The awareness program for the leaders started at 9:30 am and went on to 3:30 pm. The resource persons were Ivan DSilva, the treasurer of OBS, Dr.Asok Debbarma and Mr. Kamal Debbarma, the OBS members.

## 8.2 Atma Nirbhar Initiative (Livelihood Support)

OBS (Oisho Bani Society) called a seminar for the Livelihood support beneficiaries in Lalchari. There were 19 beneficiaries present for the half-day of the input session. The resource persons and Governing Board member Dr. Asok Debbarma, and Mr Kamal Debbarma, OBS member, were present for the occasion. Ivan D'Silva, the treasurer, welcomed the resource persons and the beneficiaries and explained the purpose of the revolving fund and seminar.

## 8.3 Orientation programme for the Teachers

On 17th July, 2024, orientation program for teachers, the teachers of Ganganagar and Kamranga Saint Arnold's school was held was held at Ambassa. The Holy Cross School Principal, Jilson was the resource person.

## 8.4 Media Literacy Program

The treasurer of Oisho Bani Society (OBS), Ivan DSilva conducted media literacy program for youths on 1st May, 2024. There were 70 participants for the media literacy program. During the session, the resource person spoke about responsible use of media and remain vigilant about social media.





## 9 PROMOTION OF ENVIRONMENT

Oisho Bani Society celebrated World Environment Day on 5th June, 2024. Prior to the celebration the plants were collected from the nursery garden. Awareness on environment, ecology, climate change, global warming, preservation and protection of environments were the main highlights. After the awareness programs the plants were distributed to the beneficiaries. About 500 plants were given away on that day for plantation.



## 10 LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT FOR THE FARMERS

Over 175 people have been supported financially by OBS ranging from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 30000 to take up different livelihood activities like; Piggery, poultry, fishery, petty shops, Mushroom cultivation, tailoring training etc to earn their income to improve their economic conditions and family quality life. For the interested women group, there is 3months tailoring training program so that they can earn their livelihood being at home.





# 11 EXPOSURE PROGRAM FOR LEAD FARMERS

Oisho Bani Society (OBS) organized an exposure program supported by Misan Cara for the farmers for gaining firsthand experience and inter learning. 42 farmers from Champak Nagar and Jampurijala area under West Tripura and Jampurijala District took part in the exposure. The farmers visited All Pohor Agro Producer Company Limited, Assam. Fr. Nabin Roshan Lakra the Director of Oisho Bani Society welcomed the farmers, the Director, Mr. Tilen Nath, the Director of Pohor Agro Producer Company Limited gave an orientation talk and arranged different animators for guiding the farmers. The farmers visited, store house and production unit. Farmers had good exposure program and learnt a lot.



# 12 MONTHLY REVIEW MEETING

At the end of the months OBS holds monthly review meeting for the purpose of close monitoring of the members and the activities. Keeping in view of proper control and monitoring system of OBS, every month there was monthly review meeting called by the director. It gave the opportunity for all the members of LAND, StAND and CBM to present their activities as well as future plans. In the monthly review meeting there was also discussion of challenges faced by the members. Apart from challenges, the probable solutions too were discussed.





# 13 FLOOD RELIEF IN TRIPURA

Month of August, 2024, Tripura experienced heavy to very heavy rainfall in many districts. The relentless rainfall triggered severe flooding and landslides across the state of Tripura. There were unprecedented humanitarian crisis claiming several lives, injuries and devastations. On 21st August 2024, the state experienced heavy downpours with West Tripura receiving 182 mm, Khowai 157.60 mm and Gomati 153.10 mm of rain. The flood has impacted approximately 17 lakh people across 8 districts of Tripura. Thousands of people were put up in various relief camps set up by the district administrations. With immediate effect OishoBani Society carried out the flood relief response in the affected areas such as Khwumlung, Champaknagar and Killa area. From the social fund OishoBani Society carried out relief distribution work such as dry ration, water, mosquito nets etc. on the emergency basis which was worth Rs. 60,500/- . On the 2nd phase Oisho Bani Society (OBS) carried out the relief work at various places such as, Teliamura, Kunjaban, Agartala and Old Agartala. Distribution details have been given in the table.

Mrs. Basiham Hrankhawl is the farmer member of Oisho Bani Society, Dingthar Farmer's Club. There are 20 members in Dingthar Farmer's Club. She hails from ADC village known as Killa Berma under Jampuijala RD Block, Sepahijala, Tripura. She is the recipient of Vikshit Krishi Award, 2025 from Chief Minister of Tripura.

She says that, "Oisho Bani Society (OBS) has done miracle by transforming my entire family. Before I became part of OBS, I was ignorant about farming and depended only on jhum cultivation. With the intervention of OBS I learnt systematic way of farming, natural farming, organic farming (Jeevamrutha and Beejamrutha), mixed cropping, double cropping and leveraging the livelihood. The above training gave me sustainable livelihood support throughout the year. I would like to sincerely thank Oisho Bani Society for inducting me into project LAND. OBS linked me with government department like KVK, Agricultural Department and Farmers' Welfare Scheme for technical support. Because of OBS I got chance to practice organic farming and my products were taken for laboratory test to Hyderabad. It was proved 100% organic for which my name was given for Vikshit Krishi Program, 2025 at Jampuijala, Tripura. I am extremely happy that I got selected as best female organic farming practitioner and received the award from Chief Minister Dr. Manik Shaha. I am always grateful to Oisho Bani Society for uplifting the poor farmers."
